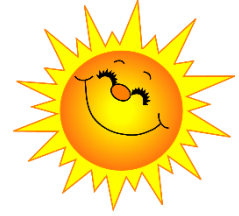

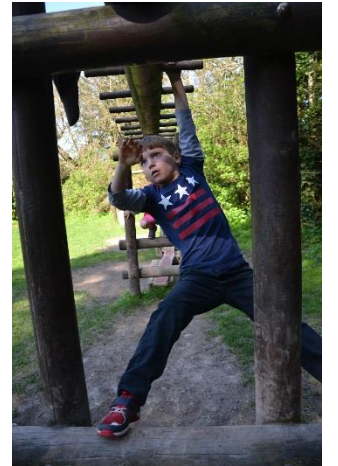
Year 1 Cambridge Archaeology Workshop

Miss Riley shared with the children what a real archaeologist's job is and why it is important to find out about the past. Then it was the children's turn to become archaeologists themselves! There was a real buzz in the classrooms as children uncovered hidden gems from the Roman times, post prehistoric, Victorian and the 20th Century. We were all incredibly proud of how well the children handled the precious artefacts as well as their genuinely interesting questions. It was a superb way to start our new topic on Cambridge.

Our trip is all about developing independence, resilience, teamwork, responsibility and respect, as well as having a hugely exciting time. The children met our expectations completely (except possibly the one about "if you wake early then read your book quietly and do not wake the others!"). Every child could add up the total cost of their chosen souvenirs and calculate the correct change due. I am most grateful to all the staff who willingly gave up their night for the children and looked after them so caringly, joining in the fun (we were farmers Boggis, Bunce and Bean searching for Burwell foxes) whilst also standing back to enable the children to get the maximum benefit from the experience. Pelican Marathon

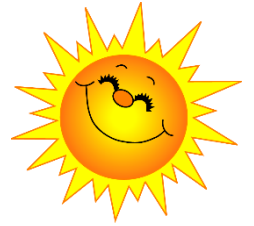
